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



COLORING TRICKS




Coloring and drawing are some of the best ways not only to promote fine motor skills, but also to work on skills like visual perception, hand-eye coordination, pressure and pacing. Plus it's good for the imagination. But there are some things that you can do to encourage the use of a mature grasp when a kiddo is coloring:


- Break the crayons. A shorter crayon is easier to hold between the index finger and thumb and almost impossible for a kiddo to hold with a fisted grasp.
- Use short and fat drawing/coloring implements. I am a fan of pipsqueak markers by Crayola.
- Instead of full-sized pencils, choose golf pencils which are half the size.
- Buy some crayons (often found at the Dollar Store or Five Below) that are fun seasonal shapes...or make your own by melting broken crayons into silicone molds. You can also buy "stone" crayons online that come in beautiful colors.
- Here is my favorite: while your child is holding the drawing implement with the index and middle fingers opposed to the thumb, also have them tuck a small object, like a marker lid or pompom into the palm of the hand which they hold their with their ring finger and pinky.
- Gently encourage a mature grasp by saying "pinch pinch" and holding the drawing implement in front of them vertically to grab it instead of leaving it on the tabletop for them to pick up.







































































































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
